TOZZI GREEN APPROVES CONSOLIDATED RESULTS FOR THE 2025 FINANCIAL YEAR

- Revenue of €66.2 million (+10%), EBITDA of €35.2 million (+14%) and net profit of €2.3 million
- The EBITDA/revenue ratio stood at 53%
- Installed capacity in operation increased to 216.7 MW (+63 MW in 2025)
- Energy production of 337 GWh, avoiding 135,118 tonnes of CO2 in 2025
- Planned investments for 2026: €135 million for the construction of 7 plants in Italy
- The San Severo plant (63 MW) has come into operation
- Installed capacity target confirmed at 500 MW with investments exceeding €400 million by 2030

Mezzano (RA), April 8, 2026 – The Board of Directors of Tozzi Green has approved the 2025 consolidated financial statements.

The Group closed the financial year with **consolidated revenue of €66.2 million**, up 10% from €60.2 million in 2024. **EBITDA** stood at **€35.2 million**, equivalent to 53% of consolidated turnover and up 14% from €30.9 million in 2024. **Net profit was €2.3 million**.

The Group has achieved **a total installed capacity of 216.7 MW** and an annual energy production of 337 GWh, enabling the avoidance of 135,118 tonnes of CO2.

The commissioning of the new San Severo (Foggia) wind farm, with an installed capacity of 63 MW, represents one of the Group's major projects in recent years and constitutes a concrete step towards the growth path outlined in the 2025–2030 Business Plan.

The Group has plants under construction or nearing commissioning with a total capacity of 101 MW. The San Pancrazio wind farm (Brindisi – 45 MW) is scheduled to come on stream in the second quarter of 2026, whilst construction work is continuing on the 56 MW solar farm at Passo Cavaliere (Catania).

The target of 500 MW of installed capacity by 2030 is confirmed, supported by a pipeline of projects under development and construction, mainly in Italy, involving **investments of over €400 million**.

Andrea Tozzi, CEO of Tozzi Green, said: *"2025 has been an important year for the Group, with a significant increase in our installed capacity in Italy. The commissioning of the San Severo wind farm is a significant step in the implementation of the 2025-2030 Business Plan and demonstrates our distinctive industrial capability to rapidly construct and commission complex plants using internal resources.*

We will continue to invest increasing resources in the development of new plants in Italy, and I am confident that our distinctive industrial expertise will help us to rapidly increase our installed capacity."

"I am increasingly confident about the growth of renewable energy capacity in Italy, because it is the only real opportunity we have to become more self-sufficient from the rest of the world and to save billions of euros a year for , households and businesses, helping to boost the competitiveness and resilience of our production system."
